Shane is currently a staff
member in the VA Work Study



program, assisting fellow military-connected students with their questions and concerns in the VAMP office. He served as an infantryman (11B) in the Army National Guard with C Company, 1-102nd Infantry. He was in for 6 years and says one of his most memorable experiences was during his deployment to Kenya 2021-2022. "Training the Kenyan Army and operating in that part of the world was definitely an experience I'm grateful for and one that gave me a better perspective of the world."

Shane will be graduating the end of this semester. While at UConn, his goal was to intern at a big bank and land a full time offer post graduation. Both of which he accomplished - last summer he completed an internship and he will be starting work at Bank of America in July in their corporate banking sector. Shane shares that he's enjoyed everything about UConn: "It's a great school. It's a great balance between academic programs and extracurriculars. I loved playing rugby my freshman and sophomore year, and I loved going to UConn basketball games for free!"

Shane has a couple of pieces of advice for other military-affiliated students at UConn: The first one is to "get involved!" He says "college can be as great as you make it. The military definitely gets in the way and can make it difficult to relate to other students. Play a sport, join a club, rush Greek life, go to a game. Enjoy your time here because you earned it." The second piece of advice is to "think about your next step after graduation. Prepare for your career while you're still in school. Get letters of recommendation from your professors. Build your resume. Internships are usually the pathway to a good job after school so around sophomore/junior year start applying."
